Facts:

Q. Why does a ShuRoo work?

A. Under normal circumstances, kangaroos do not hear the low frequency sounds that an approaching vehicle creates. ShuRoo projects a high frequency sound pattern in front of and to the sides of the car. Because kangaroos use high frequency for warning of impending danger, they take avoiding action. Or if they are "road tame" and doff the road, they will simply watch you pass.

Q. why does high frequency sound work?

A. in the wild, kangaroos are always listening for approaching danger. If you try to creep up on them, they always look in your direction. This is because their high frequency hearing capacity is much greater than ours. For example, the slight sound of a twig snapping is much louder to the kangaroo and/or wallaby than it is to humans

Q. How far down the road does ShuRoo project?

A. Approximately 400 meters ahead and approximately 50 metres on each side of the vehicle. High frequency sounds is like your car lights-the sound pattern does not go around corners or over crest so use common-sense when traveling in high vegetated areas or winding roads.

Q. How can I tell if anything is wrong?

A. ShuRoo is working when the dash light is glowing steadily

Q. Does ShuRoo work in the wind and rain

A. Yes

Q. Can I fit a ShuRoo to my bull bar?

A. Yes. ShuRoo can be easily fitted if you already have a bull bar. ShuRoo's unique sound pattern also helps protect from side hits.

Q. Is ShuRoo guaranteed?

A. Yes, for 12 months

Q. How long will ShuRoo last?

A. We suggest testing the speakers after 100.000 kilometres

- After starting the vehicle, switch the 2position rocker switch to the ON position.
 A steady green light indicates your ShuRoo is operational
- Ensure a crisp audible "zip, zip" sound is emitting from the speakers. Your ShuRoo is now ready for use
- 3. Switch off when entering a built up area.
- Do not operate when the vehicle is stationary
- 5. Do not stand in front of the ShuRoo while the unit is operating

DRIVER ADVICE

How to get the best results from your ShuRoo

Please take the time to read the following advice carefully and then place this booklet in your glovebox for future reference

The first thing to remember about your ShuRoo is that it is a deterrent, NOT A FORCEFIELD. It has been specifically designed and thoroughly tested over the past 20 years to keep the roos away from your cars, truck, 4WD or bike. Kangaroos are wild, flighty animals and can be counted on to act as such, with the only difference being that ShuRoo alerts them to your presence as you are approaching. This allows both you and the roo ample time to be able to avoid physical contact.

As the driver you can control the situation. ShuRoo will let the kangaroo know in advance that danger is nearby and the roo will then attempt to take avoiding action. If you drive in "kangaroo territory" at high speeds, it means both you and the kangaroo have less time to react.

Consider the shuroo as if it were your headlight, sending out a beam of sound, and you are well on the way to getting the best results out of your unit.

Your ShuRoo will not penetrate hills and cuttings etc. when driving through a cutting, your lights do not shine on the roadside beyond until you are nearly clear of cutting- ShuRoo has the same beam, so be prepared to slow down until you are safely out of the other side into open territory.

Use caution, especially on unsighted or blind corners, as your ShuRoo bean will not go around corners. It you are driving in hilly country or on winding roads, slow down on the crests and curves and give ShuRoo ample time to do its job – alerting the roo of impending danger, as the kangaroo has no wish to get involved with vehicles at all.

Always keep in mind that your ShuRoo will not penetrate foliage, so drive slowly in dense areas where bush, shrubs and trees are close to the road, as the

sound will not penetrate all that far. So keep your wits about you and be prepared to see any kangaroo moving closer or jumping into your path if you are driving too fast.

When a ShuRoo gets a kangaroo up and mobile, bounding down the side of the road, don't try and race him or outrun him, apply the brakes and let him get clear

The pear-shaped sound pattern will for the most part take away the problem of roos on the move suddenly appearing in front of the car.

ShuRoo is not designed to let you drive faster, only safer. You will get great pleasure in seeing kangaroos react much sooner than normal, and because they get the message earlier your lights will not blind them, providing of course you are ware enough to decelerate and let them on their way.

We suggest you stay alert and always drive with due care and attention. The ShuRoo is capable of saving you thousands of dollars from just on roo-related accident if you are prepared to use it to its best advantage.

Do not drive in heavily populated roo territory at high speeds, especially through corners, cuttings and crests. The kangaroo doesn't want to end up joining you in the front seat or being your bonnet ornament – so give him a break and drive at sensible speeds..... with a ShuRoo that's all it takes to stay in one piece.

We have not been able to cover all possibilities or eventualities that could result, however if you follow the above advice you should have many thousands of kangaroo-free kilometres.
